## ALLEN JUNIOR CLASS DODGEBALL FUNDRAISER RULES

**Bracket** format will be determined as tournament nears. Captains will receive official bracket no later than 1 week prior to the tournament.

Balls: Soft playground/kickballs will be provided for use.

- 1. A team consists of 6-8 players. Athletic attire is encouraged but not required however, clean shoes with non-marking soles must be worn. Although we encourage creativity with uniforms, we reserve the right to disqualify any team for inappropriate attire, poor sportsmanship, or bad conduct.
- 2. A match consists of 1 game. Each game will last no more than 20 minutes. The game is over when all of the team's players are eliminated, or if time elapses. If time expires, The team with the least amount of players left on the court wins the game.
- 3. 8 players are allowed on each team however, only 6 players will play at one time. Substitutions are allowed only when your team catches a ball thrown from the opposing team. Substitutes must lineup in order within the penalty box. When your team catches a thrown ball, subs will enter the game first followed by those who were previously deemed "out" during the game. You must go into the game same in the same order that you got out of the game.
- 4. Six playground/kickballs will be used. Officials will place all six balls at the mid-court line. Players must start behind their own back baseline before the start of play. Play will commence upon the sounding of the whistle or horn. Any or all members of either team may try and gain possession of any of the six balls located at the mid-court line. Once in play, the balls must be carried back to the end line, then play will officially begin--in other words, balls cannot be thrown until they are carried back behind the back line.
- 5. The spiking line/10 foot line will be used as an offsides line. The line will be marked with cones at the ends. When throwing the ball, a player must not have either foot on or across the line when throwing. If a player steps on or over the offsides line, the ball will be deemed "dead" by the offcial and play will continue. Players are not out if they are hit with a ball that was thrown on or over the offsides line. However, if a ball is caught on the opposing side after it is thrown offsides, the player who threw the ball will be called out.
- 6. A player will be eliminated when at least one of the following events occurs: (1) A player is struck below the neck by a ball thrown by their opponent (the player will still be considered eligible if the ball that struck them was caught by themselves or a teammate

before it hit the ground). (2) The ball they threw was caught by someone on the opposite team. If this happens, the opposite team also gets a player out of the penalty box. (3) They step out of bounds in an attempt to avoid being hit with a thrown ball. A ball is considered dead once it hits the back curtain/wall, side walls, bleachers, or floor. It must be a direct hit in order to consider the person out of the game. Deflections off the floor, wall, court dividers, rafters, do not count as an out if caught. Deflections off a teammate—where the ball does not hit the ground or wall before hitting the second player do count, and both players are out.

- 7. All players are confined to the out of bounds cones. Players may intentionally leave the playing area on their <u>own side</u> of the playing floor to retrieve a ball. If a player goes out of bounds to avoid getting out, the official will call them out. If a ball is thrown into the bleachers, it must be given to the team that is on that side.
- 8. Once a player is out, they must immediately leave the playing floor and sit in their penalty box. Players who have been called out cannot retrieve stray balls for their teammates, or that ball will be given to the other team. Players must stand or sit in the penalty box in the order in which they left the game with subs being head of the line.
- 9. If a player is stalling (10 seconds or more), or making no attempt to play a ball on the ground, they will be ordered by the official to roll the ball to the other side.
- 10. Allen Consolidated Schools and/or the Allen Junior Class will not be held responsible for any injury. The tournament is play at your own risk. ALL PARTICIPANTS MUST SIGN A LIABILITY RELEASE. If you are under 18, a parent must sign the liability release along with you.
