Dear School Counselor,

We hope you are planning to join us at the **2020** *Northeast Nebraska Sophomore Career Day* scheduled for Tuesday, **October 20, 2020** at Wayne State College from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. The University of Nebraska–Lincoln Extension is once again partnering with Wayne State College, the Northern Nebraska Area Health Education Center, and Northeast Community College to provide Career Day for sophomore students in northeast Nebraska. Now is the time to begin preparing your freshman class for the Sophomore Career Day next fall.

Registration Fees: Registration fee for Career Day 2020 is \$5.00 per student (bring your own lunch) **OR** \$12.75 per student for the registration fee and lunch buffet. All registration fees must be paid prior to September 25, 2020. If your school needs school board approval, please plan accordingly so payment can be made by the September 25 date.

Summary of the Day: The morning session will begin in Rice Auditorium with general college information for sophomore students and three (3), 30-minute career sessions. Students may choose to attend three (3) out of the 55 Career Sessions offered **o**r attend **ONE** of the two Health/Medical Career tracks. In the afternoon, all students will attend two (2) Break-out Sessions designed to help them prepare for life after high school. There are twenty (23) different Break-out Sessions from which to choose.

Registration: Prior to signing up for the sessions, please review with your students any career inventories or assessments they have taken. This may help them in narrowing down their selections. This year all registration will be completed on line. Please register all students by **May 15, 2020**. At that time we will begin scheduling students into their sessions on a first come first serve basis. Keep in mind some sessions fill quickly. Please note: This year again there will be two Health/Medical Career tracks (Associate/Bachelor Track and Bachelors Plus Track.) Students can register for **ONE** of the Health/Medical Career Tracks as their first choice if they are interested in a career in Health/Medical Sciences. More information and examples of each are on the career listing worksheet. The Assoc/Bachelor Medical Track is limited to 125 students and the Bachelors Plus Medical Track is limited to 175 students. Both of these are on a first registered basis. Plan to register your students early.
