College and Career Readiness

We have always placed a strong emphasis on encouraging our students to take college level courses. Beginning with the 2017-18 school year, we committed district time and money to allow seniors to use every Friday to participate in the "Fridays at Northeast" program, sponsored by Northeast Community College at their Norfolk and South Sioux City campuses. This program offers hands-on, career based coursework that meets in person on campus, giving students not only experience with coursework in a career interest area, but also the general college experiences such as navigating campus, arranging transportation, wrestling with weather, and communicating with a college instructor. In 2019, Wayne State also began offering Fridays courses. The tuition for this coursework is paid by the district, but students themselves register and do classwork on their own as if they are a college freshman. Students who choose not to participate are able to set up non-paid career internships with local businesses and attend on Fridays, or else they need to report to school and spend the day in classes here.
