Mentoring Meeting

Thank you for volunteering.

1st: Be a positive role model! No foul language, no improper use of computer, etc. Interact with your buddy in a positive way!

Be on time and let teacher know in advance if you cannot make the appt. with your student. This is very, very important.

Your responsibility for next week: Meet with the teacher of your student. Find a time that works for both you AND student. Have attendance sheet signed each week by teacher of your buddy. If you have a Jr. High/High School student, I will sign sheet for you.

DO NOT start mtg. with student until week of: Sept. 12-16th!!!

If you become ineligible, you must let the teacher know that you cannot meet with your student that week. Stay eligible, your buddy looks up to you!

Ideas when meeting with your buddy: Help with a school assignment, read a book together or to them, play a board game, color or draw, play catch or a game of pig (basketball), build something with playdough. If you need to use my office I will need to know in advance and you can sign a sheet.

I have playdough, paper, markers, games, and books in my office. You may also use some of your own games, books, etc. if you would like.

You will meet with your buddy for 15-20 minutes, once a week.

Dear Parent/Guardian,


We are again having high school Juniors and Seniors serve as student mentors. Your child's classroom teacher believes that your son/daughter could benefit from a student mentor.
